#### DESCRIPTION

Officially opening in late 2014, the Augusta Boat Harbour is a world class facility providing recreational and commercial boat owners with the infrastructure to service the region's tourism and commercial fleet; as well as serving as a regional base for sea search and rescue operations, supported by the Augusta airstrip. Located near the historic Cape Leeuwin, it is the only established boating facility located along the 430-kilometre coastline between Busselton and Albany.

As head contractor, CPD Group engaged BUSS to complete the sealing works to the floor joints of the concrete walkways. Near project end, BUSS completed a range of snag works that involved application of sealant to multiple expansion joints, control joints, saw cut joints and vertical joints, concrete repair works to the corners of all door and window frames and application of a marine grade protective sealant to the concrete walkways.

#### POINTS OF INTEREST

- Works successfully completed within specific and often limited timeframes necessary to accommodate other construction activities; and
- Multiple site mobilisations/demobilisations were required so as to adhere to the construction schedule.

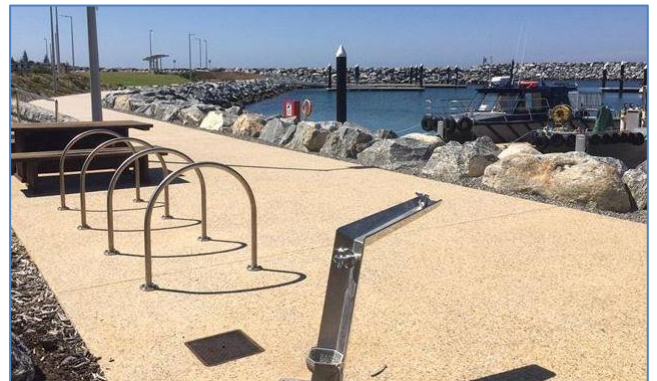


Image 1: Completed concrete walkways
